Medium-deep rub red, fairly orange at the rim, the nose is developed and mature, showing hints of spices, liquorices and dried sweet fruit; there is a slight roasted note, reminiscent of coffee; the palate is well-structured considering the vintage, hints of wild berries and a high freshness, still with a firm tannic structure on the aftertaste. Not fleshy or opulent but an elegant and classically structured Saint-Emilion; a nice surprise for the vintage that is pleasant to enjoy today.

As evidenced by their excellent 1988, 1989 and blockbuster, rich monumental 1990, this château is on a hot streak. Their 1992 is a standout effort among an undistinguished group of St-Emilion premiers grands crus classés. The wine exhibits a deep, opaque ruby/purple color, and a heavy bouquet of ripe black-cherry fruit intermingled with scents minerals, flowers, earth, and new oak. Surprisingly dense, medium to full-bodied, concentrated and tannic, it a powerful, rich, age worthy 1992 that needs 3-4 years to shed its tannin. It will last for 10-15 years. Unquestionably, it is one of the stars of the 1992 vintage. Bravo.
